

The Terry Town Council held a special meeting for the purpose of reviewing aged ordinances and discussing the hiring of a full-time Public Works employee. The following persons were in attendance: Council members Rolane Christofferson, Fred Rambur, Teneil Phipps and Clinton Rakes, Public Works Director Jared Davis, and Clerk Lynn Strasheim. Mayor Ronald G. Kiosse presided over the meeting.

Mayor Kiosse provided an overview of the interviews with the full-time Public Works candidates. After discussion, council moved to offer the position to Ronnie Parsons with the pay rate listed in the job description. (Rakes/Phipps) Council discussed the option of offering weekly part-time hours throughout the summer to another applicant. Council approved offering a part-time position of \$10 per hour for approximately twenty (20) hours a week to Robert Harrell. (Christofferson/Rambur)

Clerk Strasheim clarified some of the concerns of the council and Public Works Director Jared Davis in regards to the lagoons for the planning grant applications. The concerns that were discussed include effluent and influent monitoring and a valve/gate system upgrade, along with any other requirements to be in compliance with the lagoon discharge permit. Clerk Strasheim will follow up with Jason Rittal (EPEDC) tomorrow.

Council discussed the town's ordinances. Clerk Strasheim stated that Montana Code Annotated requires municipalities to codify at a minimum of every five (5) years. Clerk Strasheim will obtain information from firms that specialize in codifying ordinances.

Council postponed the scheduled highway clean-up due to schedule conflicts.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:47 pm. (Rakes/Rambur)
