

A special session of the Terry Town Council was called to order by Mayor Ron Kiosse, on August 30, 2012 at 7:03 pm for the purpose of discussing the 2012-13 Preliminary Budget and reviewing assessments. Council members present were Rolane Christofferson, Clinton Rakes, and Fred Rambur. Council member Teneil Phipps was absent. Also present were Clerk Lynn Strasheim and Jared Davis (PWD).

Council agreed to move forward in signing a Deed of Reconveyance for a participant in the HOME program wherein the allotted time has lapsed. (Christofferson/Rambur)

Council discussed garbage and lighting district assessments, of which rates will remain the same this year, and made adjustments to properties that have changed in use. Clerk Strasheim will detail changes in a letter for the Department of Revenue. (Christofferson/Rakes)

Terry Public Schools had inquired if they would be able to do the Homecoming bonfire this year. Council agreed to let the school have the bonfire with fire protection on site. (Rakes/Rambur)

Council reviewed the Preliminary Budget, and requested that \$15,000 for pool repairs be budgeted from the Swimming Pool Bathhouse fund rather than the General fund. They also requested some adjustments to budgeted wages and employer contributions. Clerk Strasheim will make the adjustment for the Final Budget hearing. Also, council set the wage for the full-time Public Works position at \$12/hour. (Rambur/Rakes)

Meeting adjourned at 8:13 pm. (Christofferson/Rambur)
