

The Terry Town Council met in regular session at Terry Town Hall at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Ronald G. Kiosse presiding. Council members present were Rolane Christofferson and Clinton Rakes. Also present were Town Attorney Rebecca Convery, Art Tyler (PWD), Clerk Lynn Strasheim, and Jason Rittal (EPEDC).

Mayor Kiosse called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Due to lack of a quorum present, the council was unable to take action on any agenda items. Those present decided to move the meeting to 7 p.m. on Thursday, February 16th, in hopes that a quorum will be able to attend.

Jason Rittal (EPEDC) presented a letter to the council recommending that the council pursue (with the assistance of EPEDC) a \$3000 grant requiring a \$600 match from the town. The grant is from the Main Street Program through the State of Montana Department of Commerce and would be used towards obtaining consultation for the Growth Planning Board. Jason recommended that the town, Growth Planning Board and Zoning Commission continue working, with the assistance offered through the state, towards completion of the growth policy and zoning, and we will reevaluate in May/June whether additional consultation should be sought. The council will discuss on Thursday.
