

The Terry Town Council met in special session at the Prairie County Library for the purpose of working on the budget for 2014-15, voting on Resolutions # 2014-420 and 2014-421 for participation in the MMIA (Montana Municipal Interlocal Authority) Property and Liability Insurance Programs, discussing the bulk water well, and advertising for the vacant council position. The following persons were in attendance: Council members Cindy Bond, Ken Lacquement, Clinton Rakes, Town Attorney Shawn Quinlan, Dan Rice and Clerk Lynn Schilling. Mayor Rolane Christofferson presided over the meeting.

The council did not discuss the budget for 2014-15 as there were no personnel from the Terry Volunteer Fire Department able to attend.

Mayor Rolane Christofferson discussed Resolution # 2014-420 regarding participation in the MMIA Property Insurance Program. Council passed a motion to adopt Resolution #2014-420. (Rakes/Lacquement) Mayor Rolane Christofferson discussed Resolution # 2014-421 regarding participation in the MMIA Liability Risk Retention Program. Council passed a motion to adopt Resolution # 2014-421. (Bond/Rakes)

Council Member Clinton Rakes reported that he had witnessed a company fill a large capacity tank at the bulk water well twice in one day and not write anything down inside the hut. Council discussed various options such as looking into installation of payment machines at the pump—Clerk Lynn Schilling will try to find information. Council passed a motion to lock the hut and refer consumers to prepay at Town Hall until a different solution is found. (Rakes/Bond)

Having no further comment, questions, or public input the meeting was adjourned at 7:49 pm.
