

The Terry Town Council held a public hearing for the purpose of hearing comment on the proposed sewer rate increases. The following persons were in attendance: Council members Cindy Bond, Caryn Rein, Ken Lacquement, and Tim Richards, Clerk Lynn Schilling, PWD James Schilling, Jason Rittal (EPEDC), Larry Bond, Don Haver, Natasha Hutchison, Larry Christofferson, Scott Christofferson, Margie Brubaker, Bob Brubaker, and Scott Carlton. Mayor Rolane Christofferson presided over the meeting.

Mayor Rolane Christofferson provided some history on the sewer system as well as an overview on the current issues and asked if anyone had public comment. The following comments were made:

Informally, Margie Brubaker asked questions in regards to how the current system is out of compliance, effects of the infiltration of “clean” water into the system, and the time frame for the grants applied for—Jason Rittal (EPEDC) and PWD James Schilling addressed her questions. Scott Carlton asked about correspondence from the DEQ—PWD James Schilling discussed correspondence received. Scott Carlton also asked about the “life span” of the project—Jason Rittal discussed project considerations. No members of the public spoke formally on the record.
