

The Terry Town Council held a special meeting for the purpose of receiving an update on the sewer/lagoon PER and the hiring of the Public Works Director position. The following people were in attendance: Council members Rolane Christofferson, Fred Rambur, and Clinton Rakes; Clerk Lynn Schilling and Public Works Director Jared Davis. Mayor Ronald G. Kiosse presided over the meeting.

Council reviewed the latest progress report from Stahly Engineering. Issues that have been identified include the need to get some of the sewer lines scoped as well as a high level of dilution and volume of water going into the lagoons. PWD Jared Davis will talk to Pace Construction, Inc. about scoping the lines. Stahly has also been in contact with BNSF regarding letters that the council had received about some work they are going to be performing on the railroad line that may affect the sewer main and a water line that cross underneath the tracks. Council passed a motion to allow Stahly to continue working with BNSF on the town's behalf on a recommended course of action in regards to the lines. (Rakes/Rambur)

Mayor Kiosse closed the meeting at 7:23 pm to discuss the Public Works Director candidates with the council.
