

The Terry Town Council met in special session for the purpose of hosting a question and answer session on forming a street maintenance district. The following persons were in attendance: Council members Cindy Bond, Tim Richards, and Caryn Rein, Clerk Lynn Schilling and Public Works Director James Schilling. Mayor Rolane Christofferson presided over the meeting. Also in attendance were Heather Carter, Samuel “Chip” Mintz, and Larry Bond.

Mayor Rolane Christofferson briefly discussed that the Council is looking at forming a street maintenance district to begin setting money aside for more costly street repair projects as well as alleviating the strain on the general fund. The Council is currently looking at assessing \$0.0025 per square foot. For a property owner who has two (2) lots for a total of 7,000 square feet, the cost would be an additional \$17.50 per year. The assessment would not be on the taxes until 2016.

There was one (1) comment in support and one (1) question in regards to the need of a mill levy.

Having no further comment, questions, or public comment the meeting was adjourned at 7:20 pm.
