

The Terry Town Council met in special session for the purpose of working on the budget for fiscal year 2019-20 and the provisional adoption of Resolution # 2019-459, establishing and specifying the street maintenance district. The following persons were in attendance: Council members Cindy Bond, Caryn Rein, and Peter Leyva, Clerk Lynn Schilling, Rich Miller, Susan Waples and Lizzy Robertson (Terry Tribune). Mayor Rolane Christofferson presided over the meeting.

Mayor Rolane Christofferson called the meeting to order at 6:09 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

When asked for public comment, Council Member Peter Leyva shared that he and an assembled crew of TVFD members, EMT's, and family members are gathering tomorrow at the Fire Hall training room to assemble the work out equipment.

Mayor Rolane Christofferson discussed Resolution # 2019-459. She stated that the assessment rate is unchanged from the previous year. Now that the town is fully staffed and all equipment is functional, she expects the crew to complete more maintenance than the previous couple of years. They are currently looking to begin projects on Adams Avenue in front of the hospital and have recently completed some patching and small projects around the school. Lizzy Robertson inquired as to the timeframe of the projects by the hospital to which Mayor Rolane Christofferson stated within the next couple of weeks. The Town Council passed a motion to provisionally approve Resolution # 2019-459. (Leyva/Rein)

The Town Council reviewed information that Clerk Lynn Schilling prepared showing the cash available beginning and ending within the budget of fiscal year 2019-20 for all the funds. She will provide complete handouts with all budgeted revenues and expenditures at the next meeting.

Susan Waples inquired as to rules and regulations governing the possible construction of an awning at the Evelyn Cameron Gallery. Mayor Rolane Christofferson stated that the town has adopted the state's building codes.

The Town Council confirmed the date of Thursday, September 5<sup>th</sup> at 6 p.m. as the public hearings for the final adoption of Resolution # 2019-459 as well as the final budget for fiscal year 2019-20.

Having no further comment, questions, or public comment the meeting was adjourned at 6:44 pm. (Rein/Bond)
