

The Terry Town Council met in special session for the purpose of discussing an emergency ordinance to ban fireworks. The following persons were in attendance: Council members Scott Christofferson, Neva Rathbun, and Peter Leyva, Clerk Lynn Schilling, and Fire Chief Junior Fischer. Mayor Rolane Christofferson presided over the meeting.

Mayor Rolane Christofferson called the meeting to order at 4:03 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Rolane Christofferson reported that she had spoke with Prairie County Commissioner Todd Devlin as well as Sheriff Keifer Lewis. The county will be banning fireworks this year due to the extreme drought conditions. Sheriff Keifer Lewis recommended no fireworks as well but was agreeable with a fire department monitored area. Fire Chief Junior Fischer proposed allowing fireworks on Bowen St. by the Terry baseball fields from 7 p.m. until 11:59 p.m. on July 4, 2021, providing there are favorable weather conditions, and the fire department is present. The Town Council passed Emergency Ordinance 2021-01 restricting fireworks within the Town of Terry apart from the allowed parameters as proposed by Fire Chief Junior Fischer. (Rathbun/Leyva)
