

The Terry Town Council met in special session for the purpose of considering the purchase of a dump truck. The following persons were in attendance: Council members Scott Christofferson, Tom Magalsky, and Karlene Kinsey, Clerk Lynn Schilling, and Public Works Director David Johnson. Mayor Rolane Christofferson presided over the meeting.

Mayor Rolane Christofferson called the meeting to order at 5:05 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Rolane Christofferson stated that the meeting was called to discuss the purchase of a used 1988 Ford dump truck. PWD David Johnson and Town Council member Tom Magalsky discussed the dump truck. PWD David Johnson stated that he hopes to surplus the white dump truck as parts are very difficult to find for it, and the tires are a special order size. The proposed truck is heavier which would allow them to do more with it, and it has been well maintained. Council Member Scott Christofferson asked if there are funds available in the budget for the purchase. Clerk Lynn Schilling reported that the town has set aside funds for capital purchases, but it may necessitate a budget amendment. After discussion, the Town Council passed a motion to purchase the 1988 Ford dump truck for \$11,500. (Christofferson/Magalsky)

PWD David Johnson requested to purchase a skid steer box blade attachment for \$750 from the same individual as the dump truck. The Town Council passed a motion approving the purchase. (Christofferson/Magalsky)

Having no further comment, questions, or public comment the meeting was adjourned at 6:20 pm. (Kinsey/Christofferson)
